

**Lecture: The Genogram of the Jung Family and the Genogram of Your Family and a Positive View of Family Relationships from a Quanta Universe

Each of us was born into a family system. The family is usually unaware of its system. This unawareness results in a "false self". Thus, there are many shadows for each of us to solve. The purpose of understanding one's genogram is to give more insight into finding the "real self" (Dr. Jung terms this process individuation). The process of finding the true self is a lifelong process but adds fascination and enchantment to a life's journey. Vogel will address aspects of Jung life such as early sexual abuse by a priest.
