Jung understood that the transcendent beckons us towards a greater life and a relationship to the Self. The way is often presented to us in our dreams by the images and symbols contained within them. The dream speaks the language of the antique soul, whispering to us of a world and a way of life which often remains eclipsed by the concerns of daily life and by the complexes which so often affect our perceptions.
