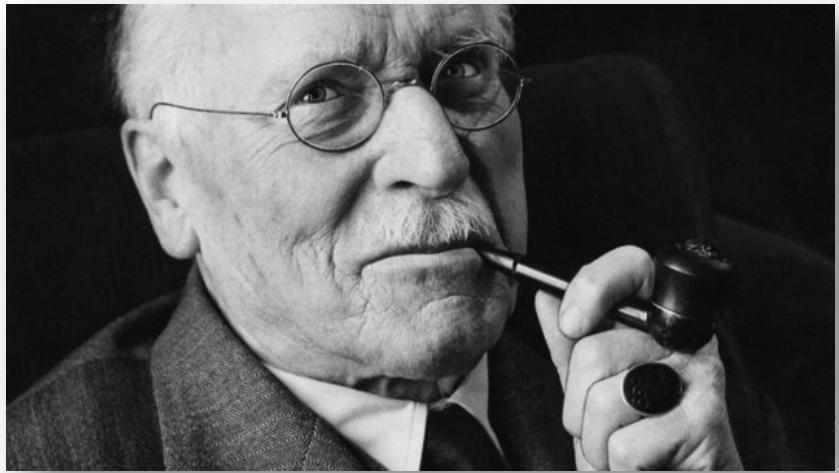

### ***As the Spirit Grows***

The Saturday morning talk will focus on a series of Jung's dreams that elucidate Jung's concepts of archetypes and symbols appearing in our personal and collective worlds. We will 1) explore the meaning of spirit and its expression through the archetype; 2) describe the process of individuation in Jungian analytical psychology; and 3) examine dreams and their guidance for our psychological development.

### ***Spirit and Archetype in a Fairy Tale and in Our Lives***

The workshop on Saturday afternoon is a further discussion on spirit and archetypes as they are illustrated in the Grimm's fairy tale, *Spirit in the Bottle*. The tale illustrates the living quality of the archetype and the creativity of the psyche. You might also want to read Jung's essay entitled, *Phenomenology of the Spirit in Fairytales* (Collected Works 9i).
