**Lecture & Discussion:  
The Divine Feminine in  
Tibetan Buddhism**

Archetypes and images of the divine feminine are an integral part of Tibetan Buddhist practice. Cultural changes in northern India around the beginning of the first millennium CE affected religious practices in various ways, including an emphasis on the divine feminine. We will explore some of the female deities that emerged from this process as well as the symbolism and energies of archetypes that are part of the psychology of the practice for training the mind on the path to enlightenment.

**Khenpo Drimed Dawa (Dean Pielstick, EdD)** is an ordained lay practitioner and was conferred the title of Khenpo by Tulku Khenchen Paljea Dorjee Rinpoche in 2009. He is President of the Awam Tibetan Buddhist Institute in Tucson, which provides classes locally and online as well as sponsoring local practice groups. His primary practice is Dzogchen. Dean is also a professor of management for Northern Arizona University. He has extensive professional and college administrative experience in addition to classroom and online instruction.

**Anne B. Parker, MA, MHSA, MT-BC** is a wellness-oriented therapist and Board Certified Music Therapist.
